Методическая разработка внеклассного мероприятия «Игра брэйн-ринг»

«The World of English»

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Пояснительная записка:

Данное мероприятие проводилось в рамках недели иностранных языков.

Основная цель мероприятия:

раз<mark>витие</mark> иноязычной коммуник<mark>атив</mark>ной компетенции (речевой, языковой, учебнопозн<mark>ават</mark>ельной), повышение мотивации студентов к изучению иностранного языка.

Задачи мероприятия:

Образовательные:

повторение и обобщение лингвострановедческого материала по теме «Англоговорящие страны».

формирование у обучающихся речевых умений;

формирование у обучающихся интереса к культуре стран изучаемого языка; расширение кругозора обучающихся;

повышение интереса к изучению иностранного языка, расширение лексического запаса студентов.

Развивающие:

расширение знаний учащихся по указанной теме;
развитие коммуникативных умений;
развитие лингвострановедческой компетенции;
развитие памяти, мышления, фантазии;
развивать способности студентов сопоставлять, анализировать и обобщать;
познакомить студентов с дополнительной страноведческой информацией;

Воспитательная:

воспитание умения группового взаимодействия и уважения к партнерам по команде и соперникам

Оборудование и технические средства: проектор, экран, компьютер, положение о судействе для жюри, сертификаты для участников.

Предварительная работа:

На первом этапе продумывается структура мероприятия: этапы (раунды игры «Брэйн-ринг») и очередность их проведения. Задания не предусматривают предварительной подготовки, а рассчитаны на тот минимум знаний, имеющихся у учащихся на данный этап обучения иностранному языку.

Обучающиеся делятся на две команды по семь человек. Каждая команда до мероприятия придумывает название, девиз команды и выбирает своего капитана.



Правила игры:

- 1. Участвуют две команды по 7 человек.
- 2. Команда, которая готова отвечать, звенит в колокольчик.
- 3. Игра проводится ведущим (учителем) и состоит из шести раундов.
- 4. Вопросы и задания у ведущего и на проекторе.
- 5. Жюри оценивает ответы и ведет подсчет очков.
- 6. Заканчивается игра поздравлением победителей, вручением сертификатов.
